

THINGS TO KNOW

“Thrill the World” – Saturday, October 29!

Thank you for participating in “Thrill the World” with Hangman’s House of Horrors! Here are some important things to know prior to Saturday evening’s event.

Location: The “Thrill the World” event will take place at Hangman’s House of Horrors with registration near the gallows. Hangman’s is located at I-30 and Forest Park Blvd., one mile west of downtown Fort Worth.

Parking: **NO PARKING in the Costume Shop lot!** All “Thrill the World” participants must park on the grassy lot across from Hangman’s in the lots marked “Hangman’s Parking.” There will be signs directing you to the available parking lots.

Registration: **7:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.** You must be registered and in position within the dancing area by **8:30 p.m.** in order to participate!

Registration includes completing the official “Thrill the World” forms and getting your certified wristband. (For those under the age of 18, your parent/guardian must sign an “Underage Waiver.” If your parent will not be with you at the event, please download the waiver located at this link and bring the signed copy with you to the event. The link is: www.hangmans.com.)

GROUPS: Please collect the forms from all members of your group and send only **ONE** representative to the registration area.

Dancers: You must arrive in Zombie attire to participate!

According to the official world record rules, **all dancers MUST know the “Thrill the World” version of the dance** to be counted. We will run through the dance several times prior to the official dance at 9:00 p.m. During this time, Spotters may ask you to step to the outside edge of the dancing area if you do not know the official dance well enough to be in the actual headcount. You WILL be allowed to dance with the group, but you must dance in the area to which you are moved. You can learn the dance from the website, www.thrilltheworld.com, as well as get written instructions if you cannot attend one of the Teaching Seminars offered by Hangman’s. The last seminar will be held at Hangman’s on the morning of the event, Saturday, October 29, 9 a.m.-Noon. Check out www.hangmans.com/thrilltheworld for additional dates and times.

Our official time to dance is at 9:00 p.m. You must be registered and in the dance area by 8:30 p.m. in order to participate! We will be on a conference call with other events around the world to “countdown” and begin the dance in unison with everyone else.

As the official dance concludes (when the “laughter” begins in the recording), all Zombies must drop to the ground as if dying. You may get up when the music is completely silent--and applaud yourselves for a job well done!

Spectators: Only dancers will be allowed in the dancing area! Spectators, family and friends will need to stay outside the dancing area at all times.

Food/Drink: Please eat prior to arrival in order to maintain your energy level. After the official dance, you may purchase standard festival fare at Hangman’s concession stands.

Bathrooms: Port-a-potties are located near the Dancing Area.

Valuables: Please leave all valuables at home or in your car. There will be no place to store a purse, a bag, a phone, etc. If you cannot fit it into a pocket or something affixed to you (fanny pack, belt clip, etc.), don’t bring it!

Weather: We dance come rain, sleet, snow or hail! It may be raining here but that doesn’t mean it is raining in Brazil or Africa. This is a worldwide event! If it looks like rain, please bring umbrellas or ponchos. The dance will happen no matter the weather.

Hangman's Tickets: At the conclusion of the official dance, each dancer will be awarded a voucher good for up to TWO half-price Hangman's Combo Tickets (normally \$20 each—your special price is only \$10 each!). You may use this voucher immediately and purchase your discounted tickets at the "Thrill the World" registration table (cash only). These specially discounted tickets are good any time that night at Hangman's, Saturday, October 29, 7 p.m. until midnight.

Media: Hangman's House of Horrors has designated personnel to coordinate all News Media in attendance. As a participant, you are likely to be photographed and videotaped by the media for publicity purposes. Give 'em your best Zombie look and enjoy the celebrity!
